3. Three Letters of Recommendation (One **MUST** be from your Guidance Counselor or Principal). Please encourage the authors to sign their letters.
4. Official copy of your high school transcript sent to the Congressman's office.
5. Certified copy of your **SAT (Use code 2885)**, **ACT (Use code 7562)**, or PSAT scores sent from the College Board to the Congressman's office.
6. Recent photo (placed in the left-hand corner of application; preferably 2 ½ x 3 ½)

Note to Applicant:

- Application and essay materials must be submitted together in one envelope. Letters of recommendation, transcripts, and test scores should be sent **directly** from author/school/The College Board to the Congressman's office at the address listed above.
- In addition to submission to Congressman John Faso, your completed Congressional Application Form (including your essay) must also be sent to **ALL** members of the Academy Selection Committee (everyone in Group A), as well as the Academy Liaison Officer for the Academy of your choice (see page 5 for details and instructions). In total, 13 copies of the application should be sent to 12 committee members, and the congressman.

ADDITIONAL APPLICANT INFORMATION

VERY IMPORTANT:

The Congressional Application Form (including your essay) must be completed and sent to all 10 members of the Academy Selection Committee (*Group A*). Upon submission, it is then **the applicant's responsibility** to contact and schedule interviews with a minimum of six persons on the Committee in Group A.

Committee members must have an application copy prior to any interview scheduling. Chairman Anthony DiNallo should receive application materials, but should not be contacted for interviews. The more Committee members you contact, the better each Committee member will be able to assess your commitment to the process, and to the Academy of your choice. Face to face interviews are highly recommended, but other accommodations can be made for dire circumstances.

The Congressional Application Form (including your essay) must also be completed and sent to the Academy Liaison Officer (*Group B*) for the Academy of your choice as soon as possible. It is a requirement to have an in-person interview with the Academy Liaison from the respective academy you wish to attend. It is **the applicant's responsibility** to contact the Academy Liaison. He/she will guide you through the application process and answer any questions that you may have.

Submissions to members of the Academy Selection Committee and the Academy Liaison Officer must be received no later than **Wednesday October 31st, 2018**. No applications will be considered after this date.

This year's **final interview session**, when each candidate sits before the entire Committee for approximately 15 minutes, will take place this year on **Sunday, December 2nd, 2018**. The location will be determined. That is the day that the nominations will be determined. You will receive a schedule, via email, approximately one week before that date. **It is mandatory** that you attend the interview. If this is going to be a problem, please notify Ann Mueller as soon as possible.
